The OGS Bylaws, Article VI – Officers and Their Election, Section 3: There shall be a nominating committee composed of no less than three (3) members in good standing and no more than five (5) members in good standing. The committee shall be elected by the Society members at a regular meeting at least two (2) months prior to the election of officers. The committee shall elect its own chair. The nominating committee shall nominate an eligible person for each office to be filled and report its nominees at or before the regular meeting in June.
