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**From the Editor:**

Over the last 5 years or so, the Olympia Genealogical Society Board has discussed the viability of continuing to publish the Quarterly. The original reasons for producing the Quarterly still exist. Part of the Society's mission is to extract local records and make them readily available to researchers. Four times a year the copies go out to the membership and also, to other societies in exchange for their publication. The Allen County library indexes their copy for inclusion in the Periodical Source Index making the information even easier for the researchers to access. However, rising costs for printing and mailing combined with a shrinking membership have made other options look very good. This is not a phenomenon unique to OGS. Many societies have gone from quarterly to annual publications and from hard copy to digital to save cash. Current cost estimates for 2009 are \$1100 to print and mail four issues. The OGS Board would like to hear from the membership.

The publications mentioned are sent to our society in exchange for our Quarterly. They are filed alphabetically by state and county in the vertical files in the genealogical section of the Olympia Timberland Library. Some of them are eventually bound and placed with bound periodicals in the genealogical section or in storage at the Montesano Library. Anything in storage can be ordered at the reference desk to be sent to your library for your use.

**Genealogical Society of Southwest Pennsylvania**— April 2008— Many Washington Co records here including Washington Co marriages, inhabitants of Wash Co in 1800 plus an illustrated article on Visiting (calling) cards of the Victorian era.

**Skagit Valley Genealogical Society**— May/June 2008— A survey by Generations Network found that 1/3 of Americans can't name any great-grandparents, 6 of 10 don't know their grand mother's maiden name, 22 % don't know what either grandfather did for a living and 27 % don't know where their family lived before coming to America. We have a lot of educating to do.

**Jefferson County Washington Genealogical Society**— Summer 2008— An account of a family's migration to Cal from Iowa in 1863. Also an article on migrations of families and a list of books you may want to read such as The Great Wagon Road, The Yankee Exodus and Westward of Ye Laurel Hills.

**Boulder County Genealogical Society**— May 2008— Do you keep a journal? Did any of your ancestors keep one that you know of? Read "The First Word: Journals are this Girl's Best Friends" to learn about journal keeping and its importance in Genealogy research.

**Whitman County Washington Genealogical Society**— May 2008— A two part story in this and the June, July Aug issue called Our Trip by Covered Wagon by Mrs. Olive Joynson. The trip was made in 1897 and very descriptive of life on the road at that time.

**Northeast Washington Genealogical Society—** April 2008— Informative article that discusses the two types of web searches--one uses directories and the other search engines. Do you know the difference? Read this and try a new tool.

**Clallam County Genealogical Society—** Apr 2008— A really interesting story of a researcher entitled *Following the Path of my DNA, Wherever it Leads Me*. She and a cousin contributed their DNA which led to a 3rd cousin who was adopted and now had a biological family.

**Connections: The Hoosier Genealogist—**Spring/Summer 2008— We receive this publication from the Indiana Historical Society and it is full of information, sources, and research in Indiana. Some of these could pertain to any state, however, such as Federal Court Records. So don't overlook a periodical even if it's not from your area of research.

**Chelan Valley Genealogical Society—** May 2008— Good article on cousin relationships that may be useful at a family reunion or corresponding with other genealogists. It includes several sites that go into more depth.

**Puget Sound Genealogical Society—** June 2008— If you like a good read try some of the stories these members write in each newsletter. Some examples "Hoop Skirts and Tintypes", "Who are these People or Discovering My Family History", and "Exploring New England Chapter 3, Norwich and Lebanon Connecticut".

**Willamette Valley Genealogical Society—** Spring 2008— Most of this issue is dedicated to Odds and Ends (mostly odds) while researching in old Salem newspapers. Here are a few--2 headed snake has 8 eyes, paper coffins, oldest man ever sent to prison here at age 91, and 6 sets of twins in the freshman class of Willamette University in 1941.

**Minnesota Genealogist—**Spring 2008— An article about early Dutch settlers in Minnesota and the first in a series of articles on African American Roots in Minnesota.

Think of it when you find misspellings, mistakes, hard to read hand writing and have pity on the person who had to walk, stay overnight with strangers and deal with out-of-control children. **Southwestern Pennsylvania Genealogical Society—** Summer 2008— If you have English ancestors you will be interested in the 210,000 trials across four centuries heard at the Old Bailey from 1670-1913 which are now available online and free of charge. Go to [www.guardian.co.uk](http://www.guardian.co.uk). These trials include many that were famous and many of everyday people. Now would you have looked for this in SW Pennsylvania? Read those exchanges.

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
